Specifically they touched on new changes to the 2007 engine including exhaust after treatment, as well as new ratings for 2007. JUNE MEETING:

Learn more about the new engine-oil category that meets the 2007 Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) emissions requirements. The new category is called API CJ-4 and was also known as PC-10 (Provisional Commercial 10). The presentation will deal with why a new category is needed, why exhaust treatment is needed, backwards-compatibility of API CJ-4 for older engines, when the category and products will be available and when the 2007 emission controlled engines will be available. Clinton Smith joined Imperial Oil in 1973 at the Research Center in Sarnia Ontario. During his 20 year stay at the Research Centre he worked in product development in industrial hydraulic oils, passenger car engine oil, gasoline and heavy duty engine oils. From 1993 to the present his role as Automotive National Marketing Technical Service Specialist has been to plan the next generation products for the automotive applications for gasoline and diesel engine oils, gear oils, transmission fluids, 2-cycle fluids and tractor hydraulic fluids.
